Flu Shot Subsidy for Children & Seniors

This autumn and winter, it is important to take precautions against both Covid-19 and the flu, and children and seniors can develop very severe flu symptoms due to their weaker immune systems. Kobe City subsidizes the first flu shot of the year for these high-risk groups, so please be sure to get your flu shot soon.

Period: October 1, 2021 - January 31, 2022

Flu vaccine cost (out-of-pocket)

Children (1-12 y.o.): Vaccination fee minus 2,000 yen (Households with 2 or more children under 18 y.o. can also receive the subsidy for a second flu vaccination during this period)

Seniors (① or ②): 1,500 yen

Seniors (③): Free

- ① 65 y.o. & over
- ② 60-64 y.o. with a Tier I Physical Disability due to problems from the heart, kidneys, respiratory system, or human immunodeficiency virus (or equivalent degree of disability)
- ③ Either ① or ②, **and** in either a tax-exempt household or a household receiving public assistance benefits

IMPORTANT: You cannot get the Covid-19 and influenza vaccines at the same time. Wait at least 14 days after receiving the Covid-19 vaccine before getting your flu shot.

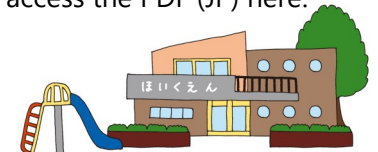
