
KOBE DIVERSITY & INCLUSION IDEA CONTEST Application Guidelines

1. Contest Overviews

Kobe is seeking for ideas to foster mutual understanding between Japanese and Foreign residents in the community to create a more diverse and inclusive society. The contest is open to students residing or studying within the city.

Application Period: From May 31st, 2024 (Friday) until July 12th, 2024 (Friday)

Target Participants: Students living or studying within Kobe City

*High Schools and Technical Colleges, Universities, Graduate Schools and Junior Colleges, Vocational Schools and Specialized Training Colleges, as well as Japanese Language Institutions

Application Requirements: Groups or individuals must include at least one international student residing within the city.

*Feel free to consult with us if you do not have connections with international students.

2. Application Process

(I) Application Deadline: By July 12th, 2024 (Friday)

(2) Results Announcement: By July 23rd, 2024 (Tuesday)

The tentative maximum number of groups eligible to participate in the contest is six.

If there are many applications, a pre-screening will be conducted. The results of it will be notified to the registered email address.

(3) Proposal Submissions Deadline: By September 3rd, 2024 (Tuesday)

If you have received an invitation to participate in the contest, please submit the following presentation materials to Community Engagement and Development Bureau of Kobe City via e-mail (chiikikyousei@office.city.kobe.lg.jp). Please note that changes to submitted materials are not allowed.

① Presentation Materials:

- Create slides using PowerPoint or other similar tool (Up to 10 pages, all slides should be in both Japanese and English) and submit it in a PDF format.
- The format is flexible, but be sure to include the following content;
 - > Idea title and team name
 - > Analysis related to the local issues targeted
 - Overview of the proposed idea
 - > Implementation plan
 - Expected outcomes
 - Conclusion

2 Presentation Manuscript:

- Prepare a manuscript in WORD format (in either Japanese or English).
- It will be translated into Japanese or English in advance and use it for interpretation during the contest. Kindly ensure that it reflects the content of your presentation on the presentation day.

(4) Participation in the Contest

The six groups (tentative) that have passed the pre-screening will compete in the final round of the contest. Each group can present in either Japanese or English and simultaneous interpretation will be done based on the submitted manuscripts. Each group will have 10 minutes for their presentation, followed by a 5-minute question-and-answer session.
